

## Classes in clinical sciences chosen by the student

Classes in clinical sciences that the student chooses themselves are designed to supplement the knowledge and skills in the field of symptomatology, physical examination, diagnosis and treatment in selected clinical disciplines. Specific objectives include teaching students planning the diagnostic process and treatment. An important goal is to teach students how to keep medical records and how to organize the ward's work. Group work planning, cooperation in the medical and nursing team are also key elements.
